Yrjö Kero founded the company in 1929 together with Karl Wälivaara and made it his life's mission to create the thriving company that developed into the still-thriving company culture in the small village of Sattajärvi, 20 kilometres south of Pajala in the arctic circle in Swedish Lapland.

These quality knives are handmade in northern Sweden. Blades made from Swedish Sandvik quality steel. The handles are made from oiled curly birch and reindeer antler. Sheaths are made from cow hide and reindeer leather and are skilfully decorated.
